

No-Cost Cab Service for Immediate Medical Needs

For:

Students who need to access immediate medical services (that are not emergencies) such as urgent care facilities or pharmacies and do not have any means of transportation.

Pharmacy rides are only for medication pick-up that is related to the urgent medical need. This service *cannot* be used for routine doctor's appointments or to pick up routine prescriptions from pharmacies.

Cost: There is no cost to the student.

How:

During business hours (9am-5pm): Students should call Student Health Services (508-767-7329) and request a cab for the immediate medical need. Remember, many immediate care needs can be resolved through Student Health Services at no cost. A health services professional will assess the situation and if it is determined that you will need to access off-campus resources and do not need to be transported by ambulance, they will make arrangements for a round-trip cab service at no charge.

After business hours (5pm-9am): Students should call Public Safety (508-767-7225) and request a cab for an urgent medical need. An officer will respond to assess the situation, and if it is determined that you do not need to be transported by ambulance, they will make arrangements for a round-trip cab service at no charge.

Where:

Cabs will take students to local urgent and emergency care facilities that in the Worcester area. A list can be found on the Student Health Services web and portal pages.
